APPLICATION PROCESSING FEE (NONREFUNDABLE)

OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS FROM EACH SCHOOL OF HIGHER EDUCATION YOU HAVE ATTENDED

Each "transcript" must include both a "mark sheet" indicating courses and grades and an official certificate of degree. All transcripts must be in the language of the country and have official translations into English.

All academic credentials received by the university in support of an application for admission become the property of NAU.

OFFICIAL SCORES ON THE TOEFL EXAM, UNLESS YOU ARE A NATIVE SPEAKER OF ENGLISH

NAU requires a minimum TOEFL score of 550 on the paper-based test, 213 on the computer-based test, or 80 on the Internet based test. Some programs require a higher score. NAU's ETS code is R4006. The TOEFL is waived for applicants who earned a bachelor's degree from a U.S. university.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT DOCUMENTATION

As an international applicant you must demonstrate that you have access to sufficient funds to cover the entire cost of your academic and living expenses for at least one academic year. A financial guarantee—in English—indicating sufficient funds must be submitted if you will need a student visa. Evidence of financial support may include bank letters verifying personal and family assets, government or private scholarships, and/or sponsorship by a third party. An authorized bank official must sign the guarantee and all documents must be originals, dated, and have appropriate seals or notarization. At least \$31,648 (U.S.) should be available if you are planning to study in the United States. If a spouse will accompany you, you should anticipate additional annual living expenses of approximately \$5,500. For each child, and additional \$3,500 is required.

Financial support from NAU is limited. Many departments do not award financial aid to first-year international students, so you should not plan to rely on support from NAU.

DEADLINES AND DEPARTMENTAL APPLICATIONS

Most academic programs have an additional form and requirements that you must complete. Most also have an application deadline. Many programs accept applications only for the fall semester. It is important that you contact the program to which you are applying for their forms and deadlines. This information is also available at the Graduate College web site: www.nau.edu/gradcol/index.htm.

For programs without a deadline, applications are due March 1 for the fall semester and October 1 for the spring semester.

NOTIFICATION

You will be notified of your admission status after your application and all required documents are received and evaluated. If the academic program has an application deadline, applications will be reviewed after that deadline. You will be notified of your status four to six weeks after the deadline. The official notification of admission is sent from the Graduate College, not from the department.

RELEASE OF APPLICANT INFORMATION

Your personal and educational records are not accessible for release to anyone else without your written consent, unless authorized by law. If you wish to have a third party represent you during the admission process, please provide a letter indicating so.
