APPLICATION DEADLINE: NOVEMBER 14, 2008

The AP New Internship program is open to full-time juniors, seniors, graduate students and students who have graduated up to a year before the internship. Internship emphases include:

- Print/online journalism
- Photojournalism
- Interactive Graphics
- Video Journalism
- Entertainment

If hired as an intern you will be placed in an AP bureau. You can request to work in a particular city, though AP will determine the final placement.

Candidates must write a 350-word autobiographical essay, get clips and letters of reference, arrange for an interview and (for those in print/online) take the AP writing test. Certain applications require other student work.
