

**Dean's International Travel Support Program 2009-2010**  
**College of Social and Behavioral Sciences**

The goal of the Dean's International Travel Support Program in the College of Social and Behavioral Sciences is to provide modest financial support (up to \$500) for tenured/tenure-track faculty for professional international travel, given the availability of funding. Faculty are only eligible for one travel award per academic year.

- 1) Available funds support travel to present papers or posters at international conferences.
- 2) Funds are not available to support a faculty member's sabbatical.
- 3) For AY 09-10, applications and supporting documents are due to the SBS Dean's Office on:

**September 25, 2009 or February 5, 2010**

Faculty who plan to travel in the summer months of 2010 may apply by the February deadline. Funding can be encumbered based on the contingency that a submission will be accepted. Please plan accordingly.

- 4) First priority will be given to faculty whose scholarly activity involves students, particularly those whose papers/posters include student co-authors.

Applicants for support from the Dean's International Travel Support Program must:

- Complete the SBS Travel application form, including the budget and information on financial matches from the department, school, or other sources.
- Explain in a brief memo how the request fits the criteria outlined above.
- Provide documentation of acceptance of submission for participation in the conference (or evidence of submission if acceptance decisions have not been made by the deadline. In this case, funds may be encumbered but will not be released until documentation of acceptance is provided).

Incomplete applications will be returned and not considered.
